Pain in Latin Literature

Pain, whether physical pain resulting from violence, war, or even torture, but also psychological pain, is omnipresent in the news and public discourse. In Latin literature too, the depiction of pain plays an important role, but has so far failed to attract the scholarly attention it deserves. As this workshop will demonstrate, it is a prominent element in Latin literature and is often closely interwoven with the main conflicts, but also with the literary, aesthetic, and political programmes of literary works. In this workshop, we will present the research project that we are currently preparing on pain in Latin literature (in particular, Seneca's tragedies, Flavian epic, and Latin elegy) and discuss it with experts on the topic who will join us via Zoom as well as with the audience.
